Other Site Characteristics

Tratto medio del Fiume Tevere comprendente l'asta fluviale ed i due bacini artificiali di Corbara e di Alviano. Dal punto di vista vegetazionale l'area si caratterizza per la presenza di vegetazione idrofita (3150), cenosi a Chara sp. (3140), elofitica e ripariale (92A0, 91E0) nonché di boschi a Quercus ilex sui versanti soleggiati e di Quercus cerris su quelli ombrosi (91H0) e di Castanea sativa (9260) in alcuni limitati settori. Diffusi nell'area ci sono arbusteti a prevalenza di Juniperus communis (5210), pascoli della classe Festuca-Brometalia (6210) e formazioni termo-mediterranee ad Ampelodesmos mauritanicus, lungo la gola del Forello sono inoltre presenti cenosi rupicole a Buxus sempervirens (5110).

4.2 Quality and importance

Area di grandissima rilevanza naturalistica ed ambientale, sia per l'ingente quantità di fitocenosi legate agli ambienti umidi, sia per l'importanza faunistica rappresentata da questa zona che, posta lungo l'asta del Tevere, si trova su di uno dei maggiori assi migratori italiani. Attualmente il Lago di Alviano rappresenta una delle più importanti zone di sosta di numerosissima fauna migratoria legata agli ambienti umidi.
