Other Site Characteristics

Area semipianeggiante di origine carsico-tettonica ricca di sorgenti dove, oltre agli habitat (aggr. a Potamogeton natans) segnalati con codice ed attribuiti al Nymphaeion (3150) sono presenti cenosi dello Sparganio-Glycerion fluitantis, prati umidi dell'associazione Hordeo-Ranunculetum velutini e cenosi elofitiche dal Phragmition australis. I dintorni del laghetto sono caratterizzati da saliceti a Salix cinerea ai quali seguono i boschi di Quercus cerris e di Fagus sylvatica.

4.2 Quality and importance

Il sito racchiude l'unico laghetto naturale montano dell'Umbria. In questo ambiente ed in quelli umidi contigui, alimentati da alcune sorgenti, sono presenti fitocenosi di notevole importanza come: la vegetazione idrofitica del lago; i boschetti a Salix cinerea (molto rari nell'Appennino centrale); i prati umidi del Ranunculion velutini (alleanza appenninica poco diffusa). Tra le entità floristiche, oltre alle endemiche, sono state indicate: Ophioglossum vulgatum e Danthonia decumbens, rare a livello nazionale; Carex remota, Carex leporina e Iris pseudacorus, rare a livello regionale. Tra la fauna è stato segnalato anche Buteo buteo, Falco tinnunculus (specie poco comuni).
